



eNWRs /eNNWRs charges levied to client/depositors by Repository Participants (RPs) for Agricultural commodities (Exchange) segment transactions.

Repository Participants (RPs) and their clients are advised to take note of tariff structure for depositors/ clients levied by RPs for Agricultural commodities (Exchange) segment transactions **effective from 1st May 2026.**

Category	Tariff
Deposit charges	0.02% of value of goods.
On-Market transactions (debit)	0.04% of value of goods.
On-Market transactions (credit)	0.04% of value of goods.
Off-Market transaction (debit)	Rs. 36 per transaction/ per eNWR or part thereof.
Off-Market transaction (credit)	Rs. 36 per transaction/ per eNWR or part thereof.
Pledge creation	Rs. 30 per transaction/ per eNWR or part thereof.
Pledge closure (Depledge)	Rs. 30 per transaction/ per eNWR or part thereof.
Pledge invocation	Rs. 10 per transaction /per eNWR or part thereof.
Withdrawal charges	0.06% of value of goods.
Conversion	Rs. 10.00 per transaction per eNWR
Extension of validity	Rs. 2.40 per MT
Inter-repository debit from CCRL	Rs. 10.00 debit per MT from CCRL
Inter-repository credit into CCRL	NIL
Account maintenance Charges (Individual)	250/- per Quarter or part thereof (at the end of the month in which A/c has been opened)
Account maintenance Charges (Non-individual)	500/- per Quarter or part thereof (at the end of the month in which A/c has been opened)
Account maintenance Charges (CM / TM)	500/- per Quarter or part thereof (at the end of the month in which A/c has been opened)

- AMC will be charged quarterly at the beginning of each quarter and in the month in which any account has been opened for that quarter.
- If a client holds both Exchange and Non-Exchange eNWRs in a single account, the AMC will be levied as per the Exchange tariff structure.
- For any client account, if exchange transactions are recorded on the Repository system, the Exchange tariff structure will apply, regardless of the client type.

Note: The value of goods for billing purposes will be calculated based on the following principle in the given logical sequence.

- a. The spot price declared by the Exchange will apply to the specified commodity and exchange for which the eNWR was generated
- b. The spot price specific to the commodity-exchange for the transaction date will apply. If the spot price is unavailable for the transaction date, the last available spot price will be referred.
- c. In the event that the Exchange does not declare spot prices for the specified Commodity, the spot price listed on the Agmark website for the mandi nearest to the warehouse where the eNWR was generated will be referred.
- d. If spot prices are unavailable from any of the sources listed above, the value of goods recorded in the eNWR at the time of deposit will be referred for billing purposes.

These charges will remain valid until further notice. The Repository reserves the right to amend these charges, in whole or in part, at any time, after giving notice to its Repository Participants.
